♠♥♣♦ Tips til bedre spilleføring

Under følger flere tips til bedre spilleføring. Det er ulike eksempler rundt viktige ting å beherske for å øke sannsynligheten for flest mulig stikk når du er spillefører. Denne gang handler det om «lasjering» (Når bør du unnlate å stikke motstander?).

In the course of developing the tricks you need to make your contract, it may be necessary to give up the lead one or more times. There are various ways to block the opponents' communication (so when they get the lead they cannot win enough tricks to set you), or at least to make it safe to give up the lead to one of the defenders. When one defender on lead can set you but the other cannot, you must keep the dangerous opponent from getting the lead if possible. Here's how to do it.

The Hold-Up Play at Notrump Contracts

One of the most common ways to block the opponents' communication is the hold-up play. It is most often used in notrump contracts to exhaust one defender's hand of all the cards he has in the suit that his side is leading. Then, if that defender ever gets the lead, he will be unable to play the suit. To get started, here is a fundamental example:

Contract: three notrump

Opening Lead: six of diamonds

You have seven winners and must tackle the club suit to get the two extra tricks you need. Suppose East plays the queen of diamonds on the first trick: If you win with your ace, the contract is safe if diamonds divide 4-4, but you will be set if the club finesse fails and West started with five or six diamonds. So you should hold up your ace until the third time the suit is led in an effort to exhaust the East hand of diamonds. Then, you will make your bid even if West has five or six diamonds and the club finesse fails.

Suppose the four hands are:

Note that East will get the lead with the king of clubs before you can establish nine tricks. If you do not hold up twice in diamonds, you will be set; East will still have a diamond to lead and the opponents will win four diamond tricks.

In the last hand you had five cards in the enemy suit and it was clearly right to hold up your ace twice. When you have six cards in the enemy suit, it may be right to hold up your ace only once. For example:

Contract: three notrump

You have six winners and must develop the diamond suit to make your bid. When East plays the queen of spades on the first trick, you hold up. East then leads the ten of spades and you should win the second trick; do not hold up a second time. If West has a five-card spade suit and the ace of diamonds, the contract cannot be made no matter how many times you hold up. If spades divide 4-3, the contract is safe if you win the first or second

spade lead; the opponents can win only three spade tricks. It is when West has a five-card spade suit and East has the ace of diamonds that it will make a difference; then, winning the second spade lead is the only way to insure the contract.

Look at the full deal to see what might happen if you hold up twice.

You may think it doesn't make any difference whether you win the second or third spade trick, but put yourself in the West seat to see what a good defender would do if you duck. With no entry in his hand it would be futile to lead a third round of spades, so he would win the second spade trick and switch to the jack of hearts. If East has the ace or king of hearts plus the right spot cards, heart tricks can be established. As the card lie, you would be set *three* tricks if you duck the second round of spades, while you would make three notrump with an overtrick if you win the second spade. Quite a difference.

The best way to block the opponents' communication may be *not* to hold up at all.
For example:

You must decide whether or not to hold up the ace on the first trick. You have six top tricks and can get the three additional tricks you need by driving out the ace of clubs and regaining the lead before the opponents can win five tricks. The opponents need four spade tricks to beat you, so you cannot be set if spades divide 4-3 whether you play the ace on the first or second trick. It is a 5-2 spade split that poses a problem. If you visualize the

possible 5-2 holdings, you should rule out West having the king, queen, and jack; he would have led the king, not the four. So it is reasonable to assume that East has a doubleton honor. Now that you have a picture of how the spades are likely to divide, look at the four hands to see what happens if you hold up your ace, or if you win the first trick.

If you duck the first spade lead, East will win with his queen and return a spade to drive out your ace. Since West has the ace of clubs he will be able to run the spade suit and set you. Only if East has the ace of clubs can you make your bid, because he is out of spades.

If you win the first trick with the ace of spades, the contract is out of jeopardy no matter who has the ace of clubs (unless West has led from the four-three doubleton, or has made an unorthodox lead from K Q J 4 3). Suppose you lead a club at trick two. The defender with the ace wins the trick and leads a spade. If East is allowed to win the third trick with the queen of spades, he has no more spades to lead. If West wins the third trick with the king of spades, the queen falls and your nine of spades becomes a second stopper. Either way, the opponents cannot run the spade suit.

Here is a case where you should *not* hold up because you fear a switch to another suit.

You have six winners and must develop three diamond tricks to make your bid. On the first trick East follows with the two of spades and you win with the ace — *do not hold up*. The bidding enters into the picture this time. West is a strong favorite to hold the ace of diamonds because of his opening bid. If you win the first trick with the ace of spades and lead a diamond, you are safe as long as East cannot get the lead; your jack of spades is a second stopper against West. The trouble with holding up the ace of spades at trick one is that West may switch to a heart.

Look at the four hands.

If you hold up your ace of spades, West should not lead another spade because his partner played the two — an indication that he does not have the ace or jack. Looking at the strong minor-suit holdings in the dummy, West should reason that the only chance to beat the contract is to find declarer with a doubleton heart. So he should switch to the king of hearts. If South holds up, he should continue with the queen of hearts. When West regains the lead with the ace of diamonds, there are enough heart tricks available to beat the contract by one trick.
